

UNIDAD 10: HERE AND NOW (ESPAÑOL)

1. Resumen de la unidad

En esta unidad aprenderás a describir lo que está pasando en este momento usando el Present Continuous. Trabajarás:

- Present Continuous: forma -ing.
- Present Continuous negativo.
- Vocabulario de partes de la casa (house parts).

La unidad incluye un OA interactivo con secciones de práctica (Vocabulary, Grammar, Reading, Speaking, Writing) y una autoevaluación (Self-evaluation).

2. ¿Qué lograrás al finalizar?

Al finalizar la Unidad 10, podrás:

- Describir acciones que ocurren ahora usando Present Continuous.
- Formar oraciones con verbos en -ing correctamente.
- Usar la negativa del Present Continuous para decir lo que alguien no está haciendo.
- Identificar y usar vocabulario básico sobre partes de la casa en frases simples.

3. Tiempo estimado de la unidad

Tiempo total sugerido: 2 a 3 horas (según tu ritmo). Distribución recomendada:

- Introducción / calentamiento: 45 min
- Vocabulario (partes de la casa): 10–15 min
- Grammar (Present Continuous + negative) + práctica: 20–30 min
- Reading / Speaking / Writing: 30 min
- Self-evaluation: 10–15 min

Sugerencia: si tienes poco tiempo, divide la unidad en 2 sesiones de 30–45 min.

4. Sugerencias de estudio (para aprovechar mejor la unidad) - Antes de empezar, repasa esta idea clave: am/is/are + verb-ing. - Haz 5 frases propias con partes de la casa:

- *I'm in the kitchen. I'm cooking.*
- Para la negativa, practica el patrón: am not / isn't / aren't + verb-ing.
 - Crea 3 frases: una con *I*, una con *he/she*, una con *they*.

- En Speaking, describe tu casa en 20–30 segundos (aunque sea con frases cortas).
En Writing, escribe 4–6 líneas sobre lo que tú y tu familia están haciendo “now”.
 - Repite en voz alta las partes de la casa 2 veces (una lento, una rápido).
- 5. Recomendaciones técnicas
 - Usa audífonos si hay audios o práctica de listening/speaking.
 - Ten un cuaderno o documento para escribir tus ejemplos.
 - Si hay Speaking con grabación, verifica micrófono y conexión estable.

2. Unit summary

In this unit you will learn how to talk about what is happening right now using the Present Continuous. You will work on:

- Present Continuous: -ing form.
- Present Continuous negative form. - Vocabulary: parts of the house.

The unit includes an interactive learning object with practice sections (Vocabulary, Grammar, Reading, Speaking, Writing) and a self-evaluation section.

3. What will you achieve?

By the end of Unit 10, you will be able to:

- Describe actions happening now using the Present Continuous.
- Form sentences correctly using the -ing form.
- Use the negative form of the Present Continuous to say what someone is not doing.
- Identify and use basic parts of the house vocabulary in simple sentences.

4. Estimated time

Suggested total time: 2 a 3 horas (depending on your pace).

Recommended breakdown:

- Introduction / warm-up: 45 min
- Vocabulary (parts of the house): 10–15 min
- Grammar (Present Continuous + negative) + practice: 20–30 min

- Reading / Speaking / Writing: 30 min
- Self-evaluation: 10–15 min

Tip: If you have little time, complete the unit in two 30–45 min sessions.

5. Study tips (to get the most from the unit)

- Before you start, remember the key pattern: am/is/are + verb-ing. - Write 5 of your own sentences using house parts, for example:
 - *I'm in the kitchen. I'm cooking.*
- For negatives, practice this pattern: am not / isn't / aren't + verb-ing.
 - Create 3 sentences: one with *I*, one with *he/she*, and one with *they*.
- In Speaking, describe your house in 20–30 seconds (short sentences are okay).
- In Writing, write 4–6 lines about what you and your family are doing “now”. - Say the house parts out loud twice (slow first, then faster).

6. Technical recommendations

- Use headphones if there are audio or speaking activities.
- Keep a notebook or document for writing your examples.
- If speaking requires recording, check your microphone and internet connection.
